Pomfret Ceremony: Noon on Saturday, December 13,
at Town Green Monument

In 2007, the Worcester family, along with veterans, and others who had helped with their annual Christmas wreath ceremony in Arlington, formed **Wreaths Across America** to continue and expand this effort, and support other groups around the country who wanted to do the same. This nonprofit organization continues the Arlington tradition as part of its mission to ***Remember, Honor and Teach.***

In 2013, **Wreaths Across America** and the national network of volunteers laid over 420,000 memorial wreaths at over 800 locations in the United States and beyond. This was accomplished with help from 1382 fundraising groups, many corporate contributions, and donations of trucking, shipping, and thousands of helping hands. The annual pilgrimage from Harrington, Maine to Arlington National Cemetery is known as the world's largest veteran's parade, stopping at schools, monuments, veteran's homes and communities all along the way to remind people how important it is to ***remember, honor and teach.***

All are welcome to join us at the Pomfret Wreaths Across America ceremony. Pomfret's event is planned by Marian Hollawell of the DAR and First Selectman Maureen Nicholson. The Vanilla Bean will offer complimentary beverages to veterans beginning at 11:30 am. The ceremony will take place at noon beginning with the National Anthem.
